The undersigned hereby agrees to pay Lake Meridian Water District the sum of \$ _____ in payment of a complete installation of such connect. The complete installation includes all pipes, fittings, meter box and meter, installed to the street or easement right of way line.

The undersigned shall pay for water at the rate and in the manner specified by the District, and agrees that the District has the right to charge and collect the rates and enforce all penalties applicable under any resolution of the District; the District reserves the right to temporarily discontinue service at any time without notice.

This contract is subject to all provisions of all resolutions of the District relating to the subject now in existence of hereafter passed. The undersigned agrees that the District shall not be responsible for damage by water or other cause resulting from defective plumbing or appliances on the premises, and the fact that the agents from the District or any other regulatory agency have inspected the plumbing and appliances shall not be pleaded as a basis for recovery in case of damage to premises. In case the water shall be interrupted or fail by reason of accident or any other cause whatsoever, the District shall not be liable for damages from such interruption or failure nor shall such interruption or failure for any reasonable period of time be held to constitute a breach of contract on the part of the district or in any way relieve the consumer from performing hereunder.

In consideration of mutual benefit to all owners of property in this District, the undersigned does hereby transfer ownership to the meter and all materials, a part of said connect to Lake Meridian Water District upon installation being made.

During construction: any damage to meter, box, fittings, etc. will become the responsibility of builder until at such time the property owner takes possession.
